Pedigree Conflicts from Genomic Testing: Sire Conflicts

Issue Date: 8/25/2014

Test results identified a SIRE CONFLICT for the animals listed below. Common causes for disqualified sires are (1) the wrong Jersey is tested, (2) calves are switched at birth, or (3) dams are bred to different sires than intended and recorded. Jerseys with disqualified sires will not receive genomic PTAs nor be eligible to be transferred or to have progeny registered until the disqualification is cleared.

If an alternative sire was discovered, he is reported in the column, Suggested Sire. Check your records to determine the most probable resolution to the problem and contact Stephanie Mack, Parentage Verification Coordinator (614/322-4458, email smack@usjersey.com). Corrections resolved by 4:00 p.m. Eastern this Friday will be included in next month's release of genomic evaluations.
