ONLY FEMALES Sired BY REGISTERED JERSEY BULLS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR RECORDING. BEFORE SUBMITTING APPLICATION, REVIEW RULES FOR THE JERSEY EXPANSION PROGRAM (SEE BACK). EACH APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE NAME, COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF PERMANENT ID (APPROVED EARTAG IN BOTH EARS OR LEGIBLE TATTOO), BIRTH DATE, AND REGISTERED JERSEY SIRE IDENTIFICATION. INCLUDE AS MUCH DAM ID INFORMATION AS AVAILABLE.

IMPORTANT: Only females sired by Registered Jersey bulls can be recorded in Jersey Expansion. Before an application is processed, the female must be permanently identified by either (1) approved eartags in both ears or (2) tattoo(s) in the ear(s) according to the Rules for the Registration and Transfer of Jersey Cattle.

1. All applications submitted must include a name, permanent identification in the form of approved eartags in both ears or tattoo(s), birth date, and Registered Jersey sire identification.
 2. Fill in first and second choice names you would like used. Names cannot exceed 27 letters in length, including spaces. Indicate whether or not the Association can choose a name if your suggestions are in use.
Jersey Expansion females will be assigned the Registry Status Code of J1. The registry status will be used as the name prefix. For example, if the name entered on the application is Smiths 9876, the complete name of the animal on the AJCA records will be J1 Smiths 9876.
 3. If assigned, enter the American I.D. number of the animal.
 4. Enter the permanent ID of this animal, either as (1) tattoo in one or both ears, or (2) Association-approved eartags in both ears.
(a) If the animal is identified by tattoo(s), the tattoo must contain at least one letter and one number. Not more than seven letters and numbers may be used in one ear. The letters I, O, Q and V may be used ONLY if accompanied by an additional letter in the same ear. Please note: Vaccination tattoos are not accepted as permanent ID for recording.
(b) If eartags are used for permanent ID, the animal must be identified by Association-approved tags in both ears. Approved tags are Allflex Tamperproof™ American ID Ear Tags. Write the herd management number on the tags in each box (right ear, left ear).
No two animals of the same sex in the same herd may have the same tattoo or approved permanent ID eartags.
 5. Give month, day and year of birth. If the animal is dead, indicate the approximate month, day and year of death.
 6. Indicate if the animal is a twin, and give sex of the twin. Females born twin to a bull must have a negative freemartin bloodtest, or have a veterinarian certify normal reproductive capacity before the application will be processed.
 7. If animal is born a natural poll, please check.
 8. If animal is the result of embryo transfer, indicate this by checking appropriate box.
 9. Write in the name of the Registered Jersey sire and his registration number or NAAB stud code.
 10. Enter the breed code and unique identification of the non-Jersey dam, if known.

11. If this animal was the result of A.I. service, please list the date that the dam was bred. No breeding date is required if the animal resulted from natural service.
 12. The owner of this animal must sign the application where indicated. If the animal is owned by a partnership or corporation, an authorized agent may sign this application.
 13. The fee for recording J1 females is \$5 (effective April 1, 1999) for all herds, including REAP herds.
